A DNA sequence encoding the mature form of Influenza A virus H1N1 (A/California/04/2009) neuraminidase (ACP41107.1) (His 36-Lys 469) was expressed with the fused Fc region of human IgG1 at the N-terminus linked by a peptide linker.

Molecular Mass

The secreted recombinant neuraminidase (A/California/04/2009 (H1N1))/Fc chimera is a

disulfied-lined homodimer. The reduced monomer comprises 692 amino acids with the predicted molecular mass of 76 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 95-105 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
