Measured by its ability to inhibit Wnt3a induced alkaline phosphatase production by C3H10T1/2 2A6 mouse embryonal fibroblast cells. The ED $_{50}$ for this effect is typically 0.5-3 $\mu g/ml$ in the presence of 10 ng/mL of Wnt3a.

Molecular Mass

The recombinant rhesus DKK1 comprises 246 amino acids with a predicted molecular mass of 27.2 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, the apparent molecular mass of rhesus DKK1 is approximately 38-43 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
