The recombinant mouse ST6GAL1 comprises 396 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 45.9 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of mouse ST6GAL1 is approximately 50-55 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
