The recombinant human NUDT2 consisting of 158 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 18.3 kDa. It migrates as an 20 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions as predicted.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
