### Protein Construction

A DNA sequence encoding the Influenza A virus (A/Albany/12/1951 (H1N1)) hemagglutinin (A4U7A6.1) (Met1-Arg344), termed as HA1, was expressed with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

### Organism

H1N1

## QC Testing

### Purity

> 95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.

### Endotoxin

< 1.0 EU per  $\mu\text{g}$  protein as determined by the LAL method.

### Stability

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at  $-70^{\circ}\text{C}$

### Predicted N terminal

Asp 18

### Molecular Mass

The recombinant HA1 subunit of the Influenza A virus (A/Albany/12/1951 (H1N1)) hemagglutinin

consists of 338 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 38.2 kDa.

### Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.

1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

## Usage Guide

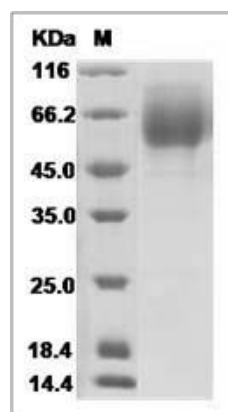
### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at  $-20^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $-80^{\circ}\text{C}$ . It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
