## General Information

### Protein Construction

A DNA sequence encoding the Influenza A virus (A/Texas/36/1991(H1N1)) hemagglutinin (ACF41933.1) (Met1-Gln529), termed as HA, was expressed with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

### Organism

H1N1

### Expression Host

Baculovirus-Insect Cells

## QC Testing

### Activity

Measured by its ability to agglutinate guinea pig red blood cells.

HA titer is 0.01-0.05 µg/mL for 1%GRBC

### Purity

> 95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.

### Endotoxin

< 1.0 EU per µg protein as determined by the LAL method.

### Stability

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C

### Predicted N terminal

Asp 18

### Molecular Mass

The recombinant hemagglutinin of Influenza A virus (A/Texas/36/1991(H1N1)) consists 523 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 59.1 kDa.

### Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 20 mM Tris, 500 mM NaCl, 10 % glycerol, pH 8.0.

1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

## Usage Guide

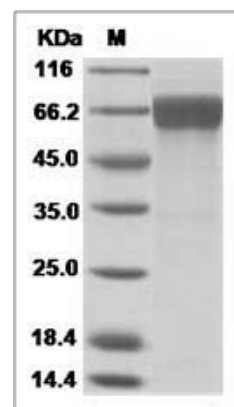
### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
