Molecular Mass

The recombinant human SIRPG consists of 312 amino acids and predictes a molecular mass of 34.7 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rhSIRPG is approximately 45-48 kDa due to glycosylation.

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
