A DNA sequence encoding the mouse ACHE (NP\_033729.1) (Met 1-Leu 614) was expressed, with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

#### **Molecular Mass**

The recombinant mouse ACHE consists of 594 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 66.2 kDa as estimated in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

#### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

# **Usage Guide**


# **Storage**

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

#### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
