The secreted recombinant HA1 subunit of influenza A H1N3 HA (A/duck/NZL/160/1976 (H1N3)) comprises 338 amino acids and has a

predicted molecular mass of 38 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 50-55 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
