A DNA sequence encoding the cynomolgus SIRPG (G7PGS5) (Met1-His360) was expressed with the Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus.

Molecular Mass

The recombinant cynomolgus SIRPG is a disulfide-linked homodimer. The reduced monomer comprises 573 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 63.6 KDa. The apparent

molecular mass of the protein is approximately 69-79 KDa respectively in SDS-PAGE.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.

1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

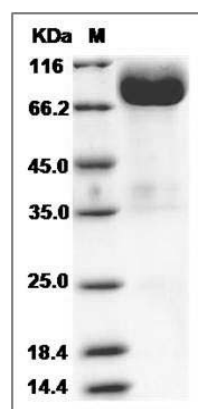
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C . It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
