The recombinant human PARVA /GST chimera consists of 606 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 69.4 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 69 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
