Molecular Mass

The secreted recombinant human CEACAM1 comprises 405amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 45 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, the apparent molecular mass of rhCEACAM1 is approximately 65-85 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- $1.\,5$ % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
