- 1. Measured by its ability to bind with Neu5Aca2-3Galb1-4GlcNAcb-PAA-biotin (01-077) using the Octet RED System.
- 2. Measured by its ability to agglutinate guinea pig red blood cells. HA titer is 0.01-0.04 μ g/mL for 1% GRBC.

Purity

> 95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C

Molecular Mass

The recombinant hemagglutinin of Influenza A virus (A/USSR/90/1977(H1N1))comprises 523 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 59.4 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 65.3 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 20 mM Tris, 500 mM NaCl, 10 % glycerol, pH 8.5.

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

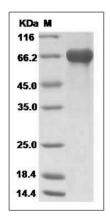
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
