### **Molecular Mass**

The recombinant HA1 subunit of the Influenza A virus hemagglutinin (A/California/7/2004 (H3N2))

consists 340 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 38 kDa.

### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

# **Usage Guide**


## **Storage**

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

#### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
