## Gln 24 **Molecular Mass**

The recombinant mouse AGER consists of 330 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 35.3 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, rm AGER migrates as an approximately 48 kDa band due to glycosylation.

#### Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.41. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.2. Please contact us for any concerns or special requirements.

# **Usage Guide**

#### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

#### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
