The recombinant human ALK6 (149-502)/GST chimera consists of 591 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 68.3 KDa. It migrates as an approximately 55 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Supplied as sterile 50mM Tris, 100mM NaCl, pH 8.5, 20% gly, 0.3mM DTT

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
