#### **Molecular Mass**

The recombinant rat PRLR comprises 221 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 26 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the rat PRLR is approximately 38 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions due to glycosylation.

#### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

# **Usage Guide**


#### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

#### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
