#### **Molecular Mass**

The secreted recombinant HA1 subunit of influenza A H1N1 HA (A/New York/18/2009 (H1N1)) comprises 338 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 37.7 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, the apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 70-80 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

### Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.41. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.2. Please contact us for any concerns or special requirements.

## **Usage Guide**


#### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

#### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
