The recombinant human CRIP2/GST chimera consists of 445 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 50.3 kDa. The recombinant protein migrates as an approximately 49 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions. **Formulation**

Lyophilized from sterile 20mM Tris, 500mM NaCl, pH 7.4, 10% glycerol 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization. 2. Please contact us for any concerns or special requirements.

Usage Guide

Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
