A DNA sequence encoding the extracellular domain of Influenza A virus (A/Netherlands/219/03 (H7N7)) (AAR02640.1) hemagglutinin (Met 8-Phe 544) (Native, HA1+HA2) was expressed, fused with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C

Molecular Mass

The secreted recombinant hemagglutinin of influenza A virus (A/Netherlands/219/03 (H7N7)) comprises 530 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 59 kDa as estimated in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

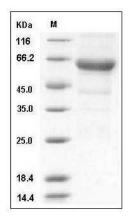
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
