Protein Construction

A DNA sequence encoding the Influenza A virus (A/mallard/Minnesota/Sg-00194/2007(H10N3)) hemagglutinin (ACT84107.1) (Met1-Val525) was expressed with a C-terminal polyhistidine tag.

QC Testing

Activity

1. Measured by its ability to bind with Neu5Aca2-3Galb1-4GlcNAcb-PAA-biotin (01-077) using the Octet RED System.
2. Measured by its ability to agglutinate guinea pig red blood cells. HA titer is 2-8 ng/mL for 1% GRBC.

Purity

> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE

Endotoxin

< 1.0 EU per μ g of the protein as determined by the LAL method

Stability

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C

Predicted N terminal

Leu 17

Molecular Mass

The recombinant hemagglutinin of Influenza A virus (A/mallard/Minnesota/Sg-00194/2007(H10N3)) comprises 520 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 57.9 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 64 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 20 mM Tris, 500 mM NaCl, 10 % glycerol, pH 7.4.

1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

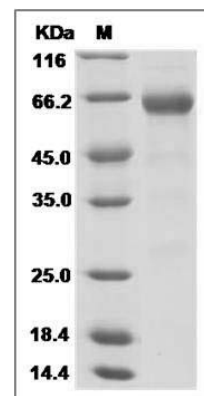
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
