A DNA sequence encoding the human APOM (O95445) (Met 1-Asn 188) was fused with the Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus.

### Molecular Mass

The recombinant human APOM/Fc is a disulfide-

linked homodimeric protein. The reduced monomer consists of 407 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 45.6 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the reduced monomer is approximately 50 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions due to glycosylation.

### Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

## Usage Guide

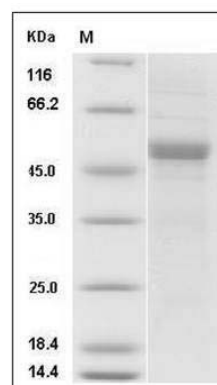
### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at  $-20^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $-80^{\circ}\text{C}$ . It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
