A DNA sequence encoding the N-terminal segment (Met 1-Arg 344) of influenza A H1N1 (A/Texas/05/2009 (H1N1)) hemagglutinin (ACP41934.1) termed as HA1, was fused with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

Molecular Mass

The secreted recombinant HA1 subunit of influenza A H1N1 HA (A/Texas/05/2009 (H1N1)) comprises 338 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 37.8 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, the apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 50-55 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.41. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.2. Please contact us for any concerns or special requirements.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
