The recombinant hemagglutinin of Influenza A virus (A/little yellow-shouldered bat/Guatemala/164/2009 (H17N10)) consists of 520 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 59 kDa.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 20 mM Tris, 500 mM NaCl, pH 7.4.

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
