Purity

Endotoxin

<1.0 EU per μg protein as determined by the LAL method.

Stability

Store for up to 12 months at -20° C to -80° C as lyophilized powder. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20° C for 3 months.

Formulation

Lyophilized from a $0.2 \mu m$ filtered solution of 20mM PB,150mM NaCl,pH7.4.


Storage

Lyophilized protein should be stored at <-20°C, though stable at room temperature for 3 weeks. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-7°C for 2-7 days.

Reconstitution

Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than $100\mu g/ml$. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in ddH2O. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.
