#### **Molecular Mass**

The secreted recombinant HA subunit of influenza A virus (A/X-31 (H3N2)) comprises 525 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 59.1 kDa. It migrates as approximately 71.3 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

# **Usage Guide**

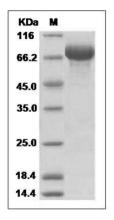
### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
