A DNA sequence encoding the canine IL13RA2 (NP_001003075.1) (Met1-Thr338) was expressed with the Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus.

Molecular Mass

The recombinant canine IL13RA2/Fc is a disulfide-linked homodimer. The reduced monomer comprises 558 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 64.1 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 66-72 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
