Influenza A virus (A/Japan/305/1957 (H2N2)) comprises 521 amino acids with the predicted molecular mass of 59 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 75-80 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
