Activity

- 1. Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA.
- 2. Immobilized recombinant mouse IL5-his at 5 μ g/mL (100 μ L/well) can bind biotinylated human IL5Ra-his with a linear range of 32-4000 ng/mL.
- 3. Measured by its ability to inhibit IL5 dependent proliferation of TF1 human erythroleukemic cells. The ED_{50} for this effect is typically 0.7-2.8 $\mu g/mL$.

< 1.0 EU per μg of the protein as determined by the LAL method

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C

Molecular Mass

The recombinant human IL5Ra consists of 326 amino acids after removal of the signal peptide and has a predicted molecular mass of 37.3 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rhIL5Ra is approximately 45-50 kDa due to glycosylation.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
