The purified protein was Lyophilized from sterile PBS (58mM Na2HPO4,17mM NaH2PO4, 68mM

NaCl, pH7.). 5 % trehalose and 5 % mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

# **Usage Guide**


## **Storage**

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

#### Reconstitution

Reconstitute at 0.25  $\mu$ g/ $\mu$ l in 200  $\mu$ l sterile water for short-term storage. Reconstitution with 200  $\mu$ l 50% glycerol solution is recommended for longer term storage (see Stability and Storage for more details). If a different concentration is needed for your purposes please adjust the reconstitution volume as required (please note: the ion concentration of the final solution will vary according to the volume used). Note: Centrifuge vial before opening. When reconstituting, gently pipet and wash down the sides of the vial to ensure full recovery of the protein into solution.
