Activity

- 1. Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA.
- 2. Immobilized human FGF18 (Cat: 500546) at 10 μ g/mL (100 μ l/well) can bind Rat FGFR4 (Cat:500770), The EC₅₀ of Rat FGFR4 (Cat:500770) is 1.17 μ g/mL.
- 3. Immobilized mouse FGF18 (Cat:501491) at 10 $\mu g/mL$ (100 $\mu l/well$) can bind Rat FGFR4 (Cat:500770), The EC $_{50}$ of Rat FGFR4 (Cat:500770) is 0.44 $\mu g/mL$.
- 4. Immobilized human bFGF at 10 μ g/mL (100 μ l/well) can bind Rat FGFR4 (Cat:500770), The EC₅₀ of Rat FGFR4 (Cat:500770) is 0.163 μ g/mL.

Molecular Mass

The recombinant rat FGFR4/Fc is a disulfide-linked homodimer. The reduced monomer comprises 592 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 66 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the rat FGFR4/Fc monomer is approximately 110 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions due to glycosylation.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
