A DNA sequence encoding the Human FTH1/FTH/FTHL6/OK/SW-cl.84/PIG15 Met1-Ser183 is expressed with a 6His tag at the N-terminus.

# **QC Testing**

#### **Purity**

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

### **Endotoxin**

<1.0 EU per  $\mu$ g protein as determined by the LAL method.

# **Stability**

Store for up to 12 months at -20°C to -80°C as lyophilized powder. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.

#### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from a  $0.2 \mu m$  filtered solution of 20mM PB, 150mM NaCl, pH 7.4.

# **Usage Guide**


## **Storage**

Lyophilized protein should be stored at <-20°C, though stable at room temperature for 3 weeks. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-7°C for 2-7 days.

#### Reconstitution

Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than  $100\mu g/ml$ . Dissolve the lyophilized protein in ddH2O. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.
