A DNA sequence encoding the extracellular domain (Met 1-Arg 182) of mouse CD27 (NP\_001028298.1) precursor was fused with the C-terminal polyhistidine-tagged Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus.

# **Activity**

Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. Immobilized recombinant mouse CD27 at 2  $\mu$ g/ml (100  $\mu$ l/well) can bind biotinylated human CD70 with a linear range of 0.39-12.5 ng/ml.

# **Purity**

> 94 % as determined by SDS-PAGE

#### **Endotoxin**

< 1.0 EU per  $\mu g$  of the protein as determined by the LAL method

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C

# **Molecular Mass**

The recombinant mouse CD27/Fc is a disulfide-linked homodimer after removal of the signal peptide. The reduced monomer consists of 410 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 46.2 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rm CD27/Fc monomer is approximately 60-65 kDa due to glycosylation.

#### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

# **Usage Guide**


#### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

## Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
