Lyophilized from sterile 50mM Tris, 100mM NaCl, 0.5mM PMSF, 10% Glycerol, pH 8.0

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
