The recombinant human PDGFR? consists of 512 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 57.7 kDa. By SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rhPDGFR? is approximately 90-100 kDa due to the glycosylation.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
