The recombinant human IDO1 consisting of 409 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 46 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 44 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Supplied as sterile 50mM Tris, 0.15M NaCl, 10% glycerol, pH 8.0

- 1.5% trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
