Protein Construction

A DNA sequence encoding the human ADM (P35318) (Tyr95-Tyr146) was expressed, with the fused Fc region of human IgG1 at the N-terminus.

Molecular Mass

The recombinant human ADM/Fc is a disulfide-linked homodimer. The reduced monomer

comprises 340 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 38 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 39 in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions due to glycosylation.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

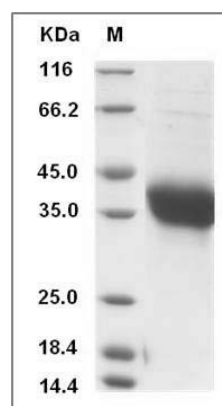
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C . It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
