Molecular Mass

The recombinant human ALPP consists of 494

amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 54.1 KDa. It migrates as an approximately 66 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 50 mM Tris-Acetate, 1 mM EDTA, 20 % glycerol, pH 7.5.

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

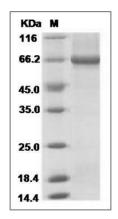
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
