The secreted recombinant hemagglutinin of Influenza A virus H5N1 (A/bar-headed goose/Qinghai/14/2008) comprises 522 amino

acids with the predicted molecular mass of 59.5 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 70 kDa band in Non-reduced SDS-PAGE and also exists as polymers.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
