Activity

Measured by the ability of the immobilized protein to support the adhesion of HOS human osteogenic sarcoma cells.

When cells are added to coated plates (5 μ g/mL, 100 μ L/well), approximately 30-70% will adhere for 1 hour incubation at 37°C.

Molecular Mass

The secreted recombinant mouse BCAM comprises 527 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 58.3 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, the apparent molecular mass of rmBCAM is approximately 70-75 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
