#### **Molecular Mass**

The recombinant full length of human COCH consists of 542 amino acids and has a calculated

molecular mass of 59.4 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rhCOCH is approximately 18 kDa, corresponding to the alternative splicing short isoform, whivch lacks two VWFA domains.

#### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

# **Usage Guide**


## **Storage**

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

#### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
