The recombinant human NCR3 consists of 128

amino acids after removal of the signal peptide and has a predicted molecular mass of 14.4 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rh NCR3 is approximately 22-28 kDa due to glycosylation.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
