Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. Immobilized rat CD155 at 20  $\mu$ g/ml (100  $\mu$ l/well) can bind mouse CD226 with a linear ranger of 6.4-160 ng/ml.

#### **Molecular Mass**

The recombinant rat PVR comprises 330 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 35.8 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, the apparent molecular mass of the rat PVR is approximately 55-65 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

# **Usage Guide**


### **Storage**

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

#### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
