Molecular Mass

The secreted recombinant mouse EFNB1 consists of 211 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 23.3 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rmEFNB1 is approximately 33-38 kDa due to glycosylation.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
