The recombinant human EDA2R consists of 149

amino acids and predictes a molecular mass of 16.7 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rhEDA2R is approximately 33 kDa due to glycosylation.

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
