## General Information

### Gene Name Synonym

Proto-oncogene c-Mer; Receptor tyrosine kinase MerTK

### Protein Construction

A DNA sequence encoding the human MERTK (Q12866) (Glu 578-Tyr 872) was expressed and purified with two additional amino acids (Gly & Pro ) at the N-terminus.

### Molecular Mass

The secreted recombinant human MERTK consists of 297 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 34.1 KDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 29 KDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions due to glycosylation.

### Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 20mM Tris, 500mM NaCl, 0.3mM DTT, 10% glycerol, pH 7.4.

1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

## Usage Guide

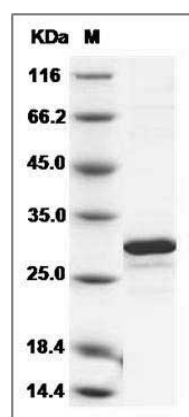
### Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at  $-20^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $-80^{\circ}\text{C}$ . It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

### Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
