Measured by its ability to induce adhesion of ATDC5 mouse chondrogenic cells. When cells are added to POSTN-His coated plates ($10\mu g/mL$, $100\mu L/well$), approximately >60% will adhere specifically after 30 minutes at 37°C.

Molecular Mass

The recombinant human POSTN consists of 771 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 86 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, it migrates with an apparent molecular mass of 80 kDa due to glycosylation.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

- 1.5% trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

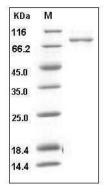
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
