The recombinant Nucleoprotein (Human betacoronavirus 2c EMC/2012) comprises 423 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass

of 46.4 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 46 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 20mM Tris, 500mM NaCl, 10% gly, pH 8.0.

- 1.5% trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide


Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
