# **Purity**

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

#### **Endotoxin**

<1.0 EU per  $\mu g$  protein as determined by the LAL method.

# **Stability**

Store for up to 12 months at -20  $^{\circ}$ C to -80  $^{\circ}$ C as lyophilized powder. Aliquots of reconstituted

samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.

# **Formulation**

Lyophilized from a 0.2  $\mu m$  filtered solution of 20mM PB, 150mM NaCl, pH 7.4.

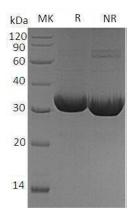
# **Storage**

Lyophilized protein should be stored at <-20°C, though stable at room temperature for 3 weeks. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-7°C for 2-7 days.

# Reconstitution

Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than  $100\mu g/ml$ . Dissolve the lyophilized protein in ddH2O. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.
