The recombinant canine IL1B consists of 153 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 17.6 kDa. In SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, it migrates as an approximately 17 kDa band.

Formulation

Lyophilized from sterile 20mM PB, 0.3M NaCl, pH 6.5

- 1. 5 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.

Usage Guide

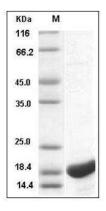
Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Adding sterile water, prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Concentration is measured by UV-Vis.
